

Announcing a Clinical Faculty Position for a Pediatric Psychologist at the University of Louisville School of Medicine, Department of Pediatrics, Division of Child & Adolescent Psychiatry & Psychology (DCAPP).

We are seeking a pediatric psychologist with training and experience in pediatric chronic illness who will deliver evidence-based assessment and treatment services with both medical inpatients and outpatients in the solid organ transplant programs (cardiac and renal) of Norton Children's Hospital. Appointment will be .5FTE with the transplant programs associated with the divisions of Pediatric Cardiology and Nephrology, and .5FTE within the outpatient services of DCAPP with the potential option of transitioning this to contracted time with other pediatric subspecialties. DCAPP outpatient services will be provided in the Bingham Clinic, the fourth oldest child guidance clinic in the US. Primary academic appointment is in the Division of Child & Adolescent Psychiatry & Psychology. Clinical responsibilities associated with this position include working with the cardiac and renal teams in conducting required comprehensive pre-transplant psychosocial evaluations, providing ongoing assistance to patients and families post-transplant for coping with the challenges of having a chronic medical condition, improving health-related quality of life and psychosocial functioning, and enhancing medication and treatment adherence. Longitudinally, the faculty member will also assist in planning future programming for direct patient services as well as research development plans intended to further promote the success of our pediatric solid organ transplant programs. The faculty member will also be involved with training psychology residents in our APA-accredited predoctoral internship in Clinical Child/Pediatric Psychology. The faculty appointment for this position is at the Assistant Professor level in the Department of Pediatrics.
