The ideal candidate will have a Ph.D. in clinical or counseling psychology from an APA approved program and must be licensed in Illinois. In addition, the candidate will have strong clinical skills, experience in psycho-oncology and specifically stem cell/bone marrow transplant as well as potential for developing patient-focused research and quality improvement projects.
