

## Pediatric Psychologist at Tripler Army Medical Center Hawaii

TAMC is one of the five Army Medical Centers. Within Pediatrics are a small Peds ward, a busy NICU and a small PICU. Catchment area is the entire Pacific including Japan, Korea and Pacific Islands. We also serve a large multiservice population here on Oahu. Peds specialties include Heme/Onc, Pulm, GI, Cards, Endo, Genetics, Neurology, Developmental Peds, Urology, Nephrology and Neonatology. Specific multidisciplinary teams are: CF, Heme/Onc, Neuromuscular Disorders and Feeding. Our center is part of CFF and COG and the new hire would be expected to join these groups. There is also an APA approved Child Psych Fellowship which includes a 1 year part time Peds Psych rotation, as well as a Child Psych internship program. The new Pediatric Psychologist would also be involved in teaching Pediatric interns and would participate daily in Peds Morning Report and Morning Lecture. This position is administratively in the Child, Adolescent and Family Behavioral Health Service but is physically located in Pediatrics Dept.

This is a federal job (GS) with excellent benefits.

Our patients have excellent insurance and essentially receive the treatments and other supports they require. I describe this job as allowing me to practice Peds Psych the way it should be, i.e., without the hassles of insurance, with excellent supports and with a multidisciplinary orientation.

There are no other fellowship trained Peds Psychologists in the state so recruitment will be nationwide. It is not posted yet on USAJOBS.gov but, anyone interested should submit their CV now to USA.gov and then apply when the job announcement appears.
