

## **Stony Brook University Consortium Postdoctoral Fellowship Program (SBU-CPP)**

### **Brief Description of Duties:**

The Stony Brook University Consortium Postdoctoral Program (SBU-CPP) is seeking to recruit *two* full-time Postdoctoral Fellows to provide psychological services in outpatient and inpatient settings within the consortium, including the Leonard Krasner Psychological Center (KPC), Department of Psychology, the Mind Body Clinical Research Center (MB-CRC), Department of Psychiatry, and several units within the School of Medicine, University Hospital. Hospital-based responsibilities include working as part of an interdisciplinary team in either the psychiatric emergency department, consultation and liaison service or the adult inpatient unit. The postdoctoral fellow is primarily responsible for providing CBT-informed psychotherapy and aiding in clinical training, including supervision of doctoral psychology interns/other trainees. Opportunities for involvement in research are available, although the post-doctoral program is primarily clinical in nature. The professional development of the postdoctoral fellow is an important aspect of the program and any/all support is given to foster it. 60% - *Direct Service*: psychological assessment and treatment  
25% - *Indirect Service*: clinical documentation, readings, administrative tasks  
15% - *Training*: supervision, training in supervision and supervising trainees

Ph.D. or Psy.D. in Clinical Psychology; Demonstrated experience in providing evidence-based psychotherapy within CBT approaches; Completion of a doctoral internship.

### **Preferred Qualifications:**

Training in Evidence Based Practice in Psychology (EBPP).  
Experience with providing hospital-based psychological services.  
Experience with behavioral medicine and/or health psychology.  
Interest and experience in clinical research.
