

**POST-DOCTORAL ASSOCIATE POSITION:  
QUALITATIVE RESEARCH IN INTEGRATED PRIMARY CARE**

The University of Vermont is seeking a Post-Doctoral Research Fellow to participate in Integrated Behavioral Health in Primary Care (IBH-PC), a comparative effectiveness trial funded by the Patient-Centered Outcomes Research Institute. This full-time position is intended for individuals pursuing a research or evaluation career who seek to develop their skills in qualitative inquiry. The Fellow is a member of the core research team.

Primary responsibilities will consist of support of local researchers, data collection, analysis, manuscript preparation, dissemination activities, and other tasks to achieve the goals of the study. The candidate will be responsible for coordinating the collection, analysis, and management of various forms of qualitative data. The Fellow will help plan and conduct site visits and interviews, review project documents, code qualitative data, conduct thematic analyses, and support manuscript preparation. In addition, this individual will be responsible for managing the array of files (consent forms, field notes, interview transcripts, codebook, etc.) associated with the qualitative component of the study. Candidates should have a strong interest in applied qualitative research and/or evaluation.

The Fellow will be encouraged to identify aspects of this large and complex research project that will assist their career advancement and to lead, design, execute, analyze, report, and disseminate this work as first author when appropriate.

**Required Qualifications and Skills:**

- Earned doctorate in health, medicine, counseling, education, a social science discipline, or a related field
- Experience with qualitative research methods, including data collection via interviews and data analysis
- Interest in health, medicine, counseling, or psychology
- Research experience in a team environment
- Evidence of being self-motivated, detail-oriented, team-oriented, and creative, with excellent interpersonal and communication skills

**Preferred Qualifications and Skills:**

- Experience with NVivo or another qualitative data analysis software package
- Experience managing qualitative data and associated files
- Knowledge of health, medicine, counseling, or psychology
- Peer reviewed conference presentations or publications addressing related methodological topics or pertinent subject matter

This position is located in Burlington, Vermont, situated in the heart of a beautiful region on the shores of Lake Champlain, between the Adirondack and Green Mountain ranges. This

comfortable but cosmopolitan city is known as a top college town and is revered for its arts, healthy lifestyle, outdoor recreation options and safety. The University of Vermont (UVM) is Vermont's public university.

The preferred start date is August 1, 2018. The anticipated minimum duration of the position is 30 months, contingent on continued funding.
