The University of Central Florida's Department of Psychology (College of Sciences) seeks applicants for the director of its in-house Psychology Clinic. Duties include supervising clinic staff (Graduate Student Clinic Coordinator, receptionists), maintaining EMR scheduling software, providing general clinical coverage, as well as developing and maintaining relationships with referring agencies. In addition, the position requires supervising graduate students in clinical practicum each semester, teaching one graduate course, and providing 10 hours of direct face to face clinical services per week. This is a 12 month, visiting position with the rank of Clinical Assistant Professor (non-tenure track).

Applicants for the position must have completed a doctoral degree in clinical psychology (Ph.D. strongly preferred) from an accredited institution and a clinical internship, both from APA accredited programs by April 2018. Candidates must be licensed or license eligible in Florida. We are particularly interested in applicants who have experience working with children and adolescents.

Compensation for the twelve-month appointment is competitive and commensurate with experience and qualifications. UCF is classified as a Very High Research Activity (RU/VH) University by the Carnegie Foundation and has the second largest enrollment in the country (approximately 60,000). The Department of Psychology at UCF has 52 full-time faculty, over 4,000 undergraduate majors, and houses Ph.D. programs in Applied Experimental and Human Factors, Clinical, and I/O Psychology.

UCF is dedicated to the goal of building a culturally diverse faculty committed to teaching and working in a multicultural environment. We actively encourage applications from all those who can contribute to the diversity and excellence of the academic community at UCF.
