

Visiting Assistant Professors or Visiting Instructors in Psychology

Overview:

Two Visiting positions to begin September 1, 2018. Candidates will be expected to teach undergraduate courses emphasizing natural science perspectives of psychology (e.g., cognitive, foundations of neuroscience, human memory, perception), and experimental psychology and/or statistics. The teaching load is three courses (12 credit hours) per semester.

Responsibilities:

- Teach psychology courses as stipulated above.
- All Stockton faculty members are expected to demonstrate, through past accomplishments and actions, the ability to support Stockton University's diversity commitment and strong student-centered vision and mission.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Ph.D.
- Documentation of teaching excellence

Minimum Qualifications:

- Advanced ABD
- Teaching experience

Only electronic documents will be accepted. Please complete the on-line application in addition to providing the following required documents. All required documents must be submitted in order for your application to move forward. You may upload documents using; Word or PDF.

1. A letter of interest describing qualifications and accomplishments
2. A current resume or curriculum vitae
3. Short (1-page) teaching philosophy statement
4. Documents showing evidence of teaching effectiveness
5. Unofficial Graduate transcripts
6. A list of three professional references (included in the application): Name, Organization, Email address and Telephone
